

Short Biosketch – Mattia Intra, MD

Mattia Intra, MD, PhD, is Co-Chair of the Division of Senology at European Institute of Oncology, in Milan, Italy, where besides his clinical work.

He is a surgeon and researcher specialized in breast cancer. He was born in Milan (Italy), where he earned his MD in 1992. And in 1995 he completed the residency program in general surgery at the same University of Milan. He moved to the European Institute of Oncology in 1998.

He initially concentrated his work in sentinel lymph node surgery for breast cancer, being a pioneer in this technique. He applied to surgical research authoring more than 200 scientific publications on breast cancer. Since 2001 he is assistant professor of Senology at the University of Barcelona in Spain, and Co-Chair of the Master of Mastology at the same university. He has been invited to give lectures in several international meetings.

Dr. Intra is a member of the faculty of the master of mastology at the University of La Salle in Mexico. And an active member of the American Society of Breast Surgeons (ASBS) and of the Senologic International Society (SIS). He is also a member of the Scientific Advisory Committee of the International Breast Cancer Study Group (IBCSG).

Dr. Intra is a consultant senologist of the Italian Ministry of the Interior. And also a consultant of the Guardia di Finanza. Dr. Intra's research experience includes principle or coinvestigator work in intraoperative radiotherapy (IORT) with electrons phase I-II clinical trials.

He have been also involved as principal investigator in sentinel lymph node micrometastasis in breast cancer.
